### **High-level delegation from the Lao PDR attends the 57 Session of Commission on Population and Development in the Headquarter of the United Nations in New York**



## Health

**Laos celebrates the International Days of the Nurse and the Midwife**

The Ministry of Health and partners celebrated the International Day of Midwife and International Nurses Day in Lao PDR to highlight the vital midwifery and nursing roles in promoting universal health coverage, including for sexual and reproductive health, maternal health and reaching the furthest behind in remote areas.

The leadership of the Lao Government saluted great investments made to advance the midwifery practices including the regulation, licensing and registration of midwives, and the continuous Professional Development to ensure every health center has at least one midwife by 2030.

A dedicated team of midwives, nurses, obstetricians, pediatricians, and dentists provided complimentary health checkups to the community.



### Expansion of Adolescents Youth Friendly Services in Lao PDR

30 participants from the Provincial Health Office, Provincial Hospital, and 9 district hospitals in Khammouane participated in the first Adolescent Youth Friendly training in the province, organized by UNFPA Laos and the Department of Healthcare and Rehabilitation (DHR) of the Ministry of Health.



### Mobile outreach to leave no one behind

Vientiane Women and Youth Center conducted a mobile outreach activity on sexual and reproductive health and rights at Garment Factories in Xaysettha Development Economic Zone in Laos to ensure that young employees receive universal access to information, counseling and services related to SRHR.



#### Provision of SRH information and services to adolescent girls from ethnic communities

In the beautiful province of Luang Prabang a group of young, tenacious girls hailing from many provinces and ethnicities are taking part in an amazing journey diving into a world of new skills. They are acquiring vocational skills such as tailoring, hairdressing, mushroom growing, and electric & motorbike repair in partnership between UNFPA and the private business: Mekong center. They joined an outreach session on SRH, organized by the village health volunteers and supported by UNFPA and the Ministry of Health.



As these inspirational girls weave their dreams into reality, they are also mastering soft skills and gaining crucial knowledge about their sexual and reproductive health and rights.

## Gender

### Assessment of male engagement activities

UNFPA visited Bolikhamxay province to monitor male engagement manual rollout. Interaction with village elders showed strong engagement to pave the way for change in the villages.

The community learns about positive male attitudes through loudspeakers, shared at community gatherings. The male engagement initiative helps inform decisions and counseling by the Village Mediation Unit.

### Government, UNFPA & UNICEF Launch Groundbreaking Report on Adolescent Pregnancy in Lao PDR


